Leaving campus:

7th through 10th grade students must remain in the classroom during the entire testing period and may not leave campus unless checked out by parent/guardian.

11th and 12 grade students may be dismissed when they complete their last exam for the day, but they must leave the building and will not be allowed to be on campus. Students desiring to stay on campus to study for exams must bring the material with them and stay in their assigned classroom to do so.

SEMESTER EXAM MAKE-UP:

Students who are absent from school during semester exams will have the opportunity to make up their exams on **Monday, January 6, 2025**, which is a teacher workday. **Students who are absent from semester exams will be expected to communicate with their teachers to schedule their make-up exams.**

SEMESTER EXAM EXEMPTION INFORMATION

FALL 2024

7th and 8th Grade.

- Average of 85.
- No more than 3 absences. (Excused or unexcused)
 - School-related absences do not count
- No more than 3 tardies per class period.
- Must take 5 exams minimum
 - Four core classes required (English, math, science, social studies)

9th and 10th Grade

- Average of 90
- No more than 3 absences. (Excused or unexcused)
 - School-related absences do not count
- No more than 3 tardies per class period.
- Must take 4 exams minimum
 - Three core classes required (English, math, science, social studies)

Juniors

- Average of 90
- No more than 3 absences. (Excused or unexcused)
 - School-related absences do not count
- No more than 3 tardies per class period.
- Must take 3 exams minimum
 - Two core classes required (English, math, science, social studies)

Seniors

- Average of 90
- No more than 3 absences. (Excused or unexcused)
 - School-related absences do not count
 - College visits do not count. Must have documentation
- No more than 3 tardies per class period.
- Must take 2 exams minimum
 - English and Bible required

OTHER INFORMATION

- Online (Edgenuity), dual credit/college course finals will **NOT** count as one of the required semester exams.
- Students exempt from 1st, 2nd or 3rd periods are not required to come to school at 8:00 on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. If they do come, they must be in attendance in those classes for the duration of the period with materials to study for other classes.
- There will be no study hall area, holding area or access to gyms or any other part of campus during exams unless supervised by a teacher or coach. All students must be in their assigned classrooms. No unsupervised students on campus.
- 2nd 9 weeks/1st semester grades will be available for viewing by Wednesday, 1-8-25.
